About Corporate Relocation Council – Chicago, Annual Scholarship: CRC is a non-profit organization that brings together corporations and global relocation service providers in Chicago for the primary purpose of providing educational information and current industry updates to its members. School can be an especially important part of the relocation process for children moving into the Chicagoland area. As part of our commitment to Global Relocation, CRC sponsors an annual scholarship for current high school seniors who relocated into the Chicagoland area between grades 9 and 12 due to a parent's job relocation.

Evaluation Criteria: CRC will select one scholarship winner annually based on the strength of their total application package. The student will be evaluated on academic performance, extra-curricular activities, and on their essay response addressing the way in which they handled the challenges associated with relocating to the Chicagoland area and adjusting to a new high school.

Application Requirements (*must meet all four*):

- Relocated between grades 9 and 12
- Relocated more than 50 miles
- Changed schools due to their parent's job relocation to the Chicagoland area
- Currently an enrolled Senior in good standing in a Chicagoland area high school
 - Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry, Will counties Illinois
- Currently have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a scale of 4.0 (or equivalent achievement on a different scale)

- **Essay** (*Essay should be in a Word document format and be between 1,000 to 1,500 words. Your essay should address your experiences associated with your relocation into the Chicago area. Please feel free to discuss your family background, challenges encountered with the relocation, and successes achieved. Provide any advice you would give to another teenager preparing to relocate (as you did)!*)

High School Guidance Department/Student: Please submit:

- **Student Application** (*Top section, completed by student; Bottom section, completed by school*)
- **Extra-Curricular Activities** (*Created by student*)
- **Essay** (*Created by student*)
- **High School Transcript** (*Provided by High School*)

The winner will be asked to present their essays at CRC's spring meeting.
